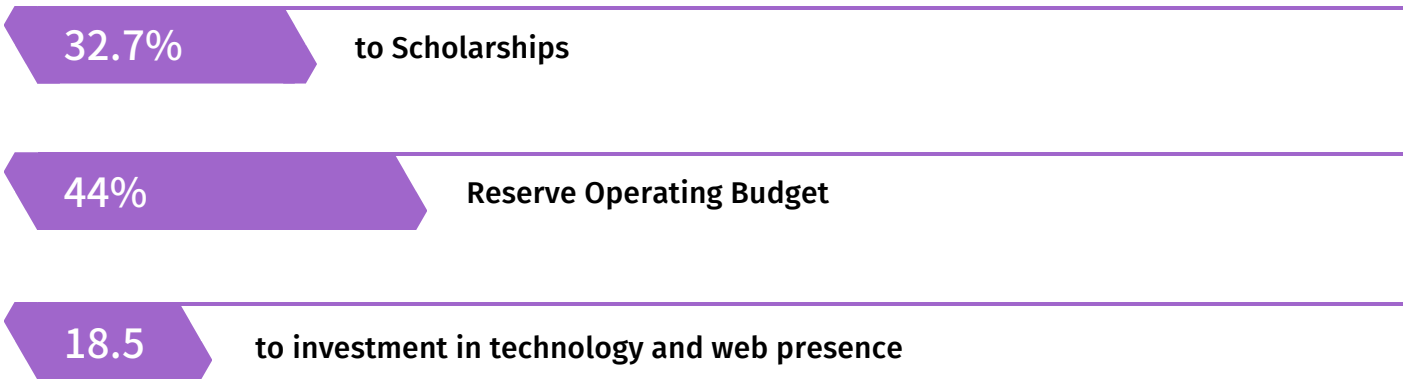
Vision
